Nortek Deployment software

A web-based application called Nortek Deployment is used to operate and configure the Generation 2 AWACs. This software can be launched from your web browser by visiting deployment.nortekgroup.com, but can also be installed from Microsoft Store or downloaded as an offline installer file.



Connecting to the software

Connect the instrument (via ethernet) to your computer using the supplied ethernet cable. Make sure the instrument is powered using the external power supply.

How to connect to your instrument is described step-by-step in the Nortek deployment software help wizard under the **Connection** tab



If you need to plan your deployment without being connected to an instrument, you can do so in the software by connecting to a **virtual instrument**



Once you've completed all the steps, the instrument should be connected.
